**Amendment of Stay at Home Order pertaining to the curfew regulations.**

**#185:05/20**

**A motion was made by Alderman Davis, seconded by Alderman Frazier to amend the Stay Home order:**

Section 6: Effective immediately, and to remain in full force and effect until 11:59 p.m. on May 31, 2020, unless rescinded, modified or extended by Motion and Order of the governing authorities of the City of Natchez, the Mayor and Board of Aldermen have determined that it is necessary to adopt and does hereby adopt the Resolution issued by the Adams County Board of Supervisors amending the curfew in Adams County as it pertains to the City, i.e., said curfew will be from 11:00 p.m. until 5 a.m. every day until 11:59 p.m. on May 31, 2020, provided however, all persons over the age of 21 years will be exempt from the curfew to travel to, from and while patronizing any business lawfully operating under the current Stay At Home Order dated May12, 2020 of the City of Natchez as well as other businesses being authorized to operate pursuant to their particular state agency orders, such as the Mississippi Gaming Commission provided that no person shall be allowed to loiter outside any of the said businesses and further that any person violating said curfew in the City of Natchez shall be subject to the fines and penalties as provided for in Section 7 of this Stay at Home Order.




